

## **The RA Code of Administrative Violations**

### **Article 189<sup>7</sup>**

#### **Failure to comply with the obligation to provide information**

Unlawful failure to provide information by the state and local self-government bodies, state offices, organizations financed from the state budget, as well as private organizations of public importance and their state officials

leads to the imposition of a fine at the rate from tenfold to fiftyfold size of the minimum salary.

The same violation, which was done for the second time during one year after imposing the administrative penalty

leads to the imposition of a fine at the rate from fiftyfold to hundredfold size of the minimum salary.
